Dear Athletes,

The Wyoming Celtic Festival will be held on June 27 & 28, 2009 at Complex Park Gillette, WY. On Saturday June 27, 2009 we will contest all of the competitive athletics, Men's A, B, C, Masters, <190#, and Women's Amateur. On Sunday June 28, 2009 we will host an "Open Field" starting at 10:00AM & last until 12:00 noon; this is for athletes that would like some extra time on the field and for people that would like to try one or all the events in a teaching, non-competitive atmosphere. This has proved to be a good time for athletes to get a little more time on the height events since the standards are up. This also would be a good time to introduce someone to the sport.

The Competition will start promptly at 9:30 AM on Saturday. Please be on the field no later than 8:15 AM if you are competing. Awards will be given for the top three athletes in each class. Events to be contested are: Open Stone Put, Heavy Weight for Distance, Light Weight for Distance, Light Hammer, Caber, Sheaf Toss, and Weight for Height (7 events). Classes will be limited to 10 in each class and will be filled in the order that I receive the entry forms. If the class you want to compete in is already full, I will contact you and give you the first opportunity to enter in another class. There is a \$30.00 entry fee to cover the price of a gate pass and an athlete's T-shirt (pre-registering athletes only). Pre-registering ends June 12, 2009. Water and lunch will be provided to all registered athletes. We fully realize that this is a short time frame for you to plan your trip Wyoming in order to be part of this fabulous festival. However, we will do our utmost to make sure you have a great time.

As part of this year's festival Seven Nations will be performing on both days of the festival and at the ceillidh on Saturday night. The Board of Directors have agreed to put together as many tables as necessary to accommodate all athletes who decided to attend. Tradition dictates that as many athletes who make themselves available get together and have dinner on Saturday evening in order to rehash the day's events and continued to form lasting relationships. I believe that most athletes would enjoy listening to this outstanding Celtic rock band so, we are offering ceillidh tickets on this entry form. Please see the festival website for more details.

1. Entry cost is \$30.00 for the Heavy Events (**All who pre-register are guaranteed an event shirt**) entries are limited to 10 athletes per class. Field entries accepted before 8:30 am, only if room is available.
2. Competitors must enter and compete in all events to be eligible for overall athlete.
3. **Athletes must be at least 16 years of age to compete.**
4. Athletes must be registered and on the field before the first event begins.
5. A Waiver **MUST** be signed.
6. All efforts should be made to wear a Kilt and Scottish Hose.
7. Judge's and Athletic Director's decisions are final. The Judge has the ability to disqualify any competitor.
8. All Heavy Events will be governed by the Rocky Mountain Scottish Athletes rules.
9. Any person competing, Judging, helping or otherwise **MUST** sign a waiver to be allowed on the competition field.
10. Athletes are expected to conduct themselves in a professional manner, including maintaining a friendly and respectful attitude towards the public, staff and other participants.
